Cincinnati Goetta Discussion at German Heritage Museum

Local historian Dann Woellert will discuss his new book, *Cincinnati Goetta: A Delectable History*, at the German Heritage Museum on Sunday, August 4 at 2:00 P.M. His book was published by the History Press and will be available for signing. Goetta is unique to our area and reflects the German immigration from northwest Germany. Woellert will explain its origins, how it came to Cincinnati, and how it became such a popular food item. The German Heritage Museum is located at 4764 West Fork Road, Cincinnati, OH 45247.
